## ITINERARY / PROGRAM

### DAY 01 MANILA / VIENNA

Evening check-in at the airport for your flight to Vienna.

### DAY 02 VEINNA (D)

Depart Manila on board for your flight to Vienna. Enjoy in-flight meals and entertainment. Upon arrival, proceed to the exit and meet our representative who will meet and assist you then transfer to your hotel for check-in. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

### DAY 03 VIENNA-BUDAPEST (ABF, D)

Morning sightseeing tour of Vienna includes a visit to the Schonbrunn Palace. Then drive along the Ringstrasse and see the Town Hall, the State Opera House, the Museums of Natural History and Contemporary Arts, the Belvedere Palace, St. Stephen Cathedral, Prater Amusement Park with its giant Ferris wheel and the ultra-modern United Nations headquarters in the new part of the city. Then cross the Hungarian border to the twin city of Buda and Pest.

### DAY 04 BUDAPEST (ABF, D)

Guided sightseeing today starts with the Castle Hill, the Fisherman's Bastion to enjoy a panoramic view of the sprawling city, the 13th century Matthias Coronation Church, the Citadel on Mount Gellert and the Heroes Square. Afternoon is free to enjoy this twin city at your own pace.

### DAY 05 BUDAPEST-WADOWICE-CRACOW (ABF, D)

Cross the Polish border today and stop in Wadowice to visit the birthplace of Pope John Paul II. Then on to historic Cracow.

### DAY 06 CRACOW (ABF, D)

Morning visit to the Shrine of Sister Faustina in Lagiewniki to visit the Convent where she spend her life as a nun and also spend some time for private devotion. In the afternoon, visit the world-famous Wieliczka Saltmines.

### DAY 07 CRACOW (ABF, D)

Drive to Auschwitz and visit what is left of the Concentration Camp, a chilling reminder of the Holocaust. Afterwards, continue to your drive to Czestochowa to visit the Jasna Gora Monastery to see the venerated "Black Madonna." Return to Cracow in time for dinner.

### DAY 08 CRACOW-PRAGUE (ABF, D)

More of Polish countryside sceneries as you make your way to the Czech border. Then continue your drive to reach the capital city, Prague.

### DAY 09 PRAGUE (ABF, D)

Morning sightseeing tour reveals why Prague is considered one of Europe's most attractive capitals. See the 1,000-year-old Hradcany Castle, former residence of Bohemian kings, St. Vitus Cathedral, the Old Town, St. Charles Bridge, the Jewish Ghetto, Astronomical Clock and a visit to the Our Lady of Victorious Church to see the Sto. Nino de Praga. The rest of the day is free to mix with the locals in Wenceslaus Square.

### DAY 10 PRAGUE-SALZBURG (ABF, D)

Today, enjoy more spectacular vistas as you enter border of Austria. Upon arrival in Salzburg, proceed to a sightseeing which features the beautiful Mirabelle Gardens, the Old Town where you will see the house of Mozart and the historic Salzburg Cathedral. After dinner, check-in to your hotel for overnight.

### DAY 11 SALZBURG-INNSBRUCK-VADUZ- LUCERNE (ABF, D)

After breakfast, continue your journey to visit the town of Innsbruck, capital of the province of Tyrol and see the famous Golden Roof and a chance to shop for Swarovski Crystal products. Then drive to Liechtenstein and stop in the capital Vaduz for photos of the Castel of Vaduz perched on a hill-top. Afterwards, on to your hotel in Lucerne.

### DAY 12 LUCERNE (ABF, D)

Drive to Engelberg and take your Cable Car ride up to the resort of Mt. Titlis, 10,000-feet above sea-level. Enjoy the spectacular view and the all year-round snow. Then return to Lucerne for a visit to the famous Lion Monument before spending the rest of the day to shop for world class Swiss products such as knives, chocolates, Bally shoes and perhaps, a Rolex watch!!!

### DAY 13 LUCERNE-PARIS (ABF, D)

After breakfast, continue your journey crossing the French border to their glittering capital, Paris!

### DAY 14 PARIS (ABF, D)

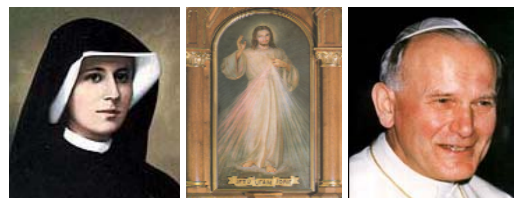
