

MANILA CITY TOUR



The interesting highlights are Fort Santiago, built in 1663 inside the older Walled City of Intramuros (1591-1593) and used by the Spanish as military headquarters. San Agustin Church, the oldest stone church in the city which has a museum of religious and secular art. The Rizal Park where the remains of the country's national hero, Dr. Jose Rizal, lie within the cornerstones of the monument. Proceed to a rolling tour of scenic Roxas Boulevard fronting the Manila Bay. A visit to a curio of Filipino crafts is a must for a change in your shopping environment before driving back to your hotel.

MUSEUM TOUR



This date with history immerses visitors to the rich cultural and religious heritage of the pre-colonial and modern Philippines displayed in its various museums. The San Agustin Church, a UNESCO World Heritage icon, is the repository of antique relics of the Catholic Church. The 18th century Casa Manila showcases a colonial lifestyle; the Bahay Tsinoy is a museum of Chinese-Filipinos; the centuries relation left their impact and influences on all aspects of Philippine culture.

VILLA ESCUDERO



Two-and-a-half hours south of Manila is the quaint and historic Villa Escudero, amidst coconut palms, reminiscent of old plantation life. Highlight of the tour is a family museum of archaeological artifacts and private collections of antique relics from Pre-History, Spanish time and World War II. Local folks will serenade you on board water buffalo-drawn carts that transport you going to a man-made waterfalls that provides hydroelectric power to the plantation. Lunch is served on tables set over a flowing stream. On weekends, a cultural show is presented for the delight of plantation visitors.

HIDDEN VALLEY SPRINGS



An ecological tour to a unique place called Hidden Valley. Its well-preserved and protected vegetation flourishes in a 300 feet deep crater covering an area of 110 hectares believed to have been formed by volcanic upheaval thousands of years ago. A private resort that boasts of a virgin forest, century old trees, giant ferns, wild orchids, hidden waterfalls, and several natural spring pools consummates the exhilarating ambiance. A nature lovers' haven for the dipping guarantees a well-spent day.

TAGAYTAY RIDGE TOUR



At 2,250 ft above sea level, Tagaytay Ridge offers a magnificent view of the smallest and lowest volcano in the world, Taal Volcano, resting in the middle of serene Taal Lake. A deceptive tranquility; notable are the eruptions in 1716 and 1754 where ashes spewed by the volcano darkened the skies combined with rains and thunder, massive earthquakes, and gigantic waves driving the residents around the lake to the inner towns for refuge. The 1911 eruption claimed 1,300 lives, and 300 more in 1965 burying 6 barrios. Visit People's Park in the Sky providing a picturesque 360 degrees view of the three provinces south of Metro Manila and westward to the sea. The tour also provides a visit to GBR Museum which houses more than 3,000 vintage paintings and photographs of the Philippines, antique maps and imperial glass pieces from China and other vintage articles. Lunch will be

taken in a cozy restaurant by the lake or overlooking the lake & the volcano.

TAAL VOLCANO ISLAND TREKKING TOUR



Drive through the scenic countryside to the ridge of Tagaytay and down to the town of Talisay in Batangas. Upon arrival, board motorized outriggers to Taal Volcano Island 30 minutes away. Light trekkers can view the caldera from the rim of the crater. Islanders are renting out horses for minimal fee. Strong trekkers can hike through the expanse of hardened black lava up to an easy incline and down to the crater for a close-up view of the caldera. The lake inside the crater invites hikers to a relaxing swim. Return to a shoreline resort for a sumptuous lunch.

SAIL TO CORREGIDOR



Discover the defenses of the island fortress of Corregidor, dubbed as the "Gibraltar of the Pacific" during World War II. Long-range artilleries you have never seen before, mortars, gun emplacements, arsenals, maze of tunnels, and mile long barracks of the defiant defenders who broke the Japanese Imperial Army's timetable of conquest. Located in the mouth of Manila Bay, the Corregidor Island Group are the most formidable harbor defenses of Manila during the war. Feel the drama as it unfolds in the Malinta Tunnel Lights and Sounds Multi-vision Show. A luxurious 150-seater ferryboat will cruise you to history in just over an hour. Lunch will be served at the resort.

PAGSANJAN GORGE & FALLS



A 3-hour drive to the countryside south of Manila to the old town of Pagsanjan. A riverside resort provides a "banca" (a dugout canoe) for the trip to the falls. Be prepared to get wet, water runs deep and strong in the Pagsanjan River, benevolent at times but not manageable during stormy weather when rain prods white-water mass racing downstream. At the falls, you may opt to ride a bamboo raft that will take you underneath the waterfalls to experience the thunderous cascade of water coming from 70 ft. above. Your return trip is another beguiling and thrilling boat ride experience as you "shoot the rapids" going downstream. Watch your boatman as they skillfully maneuver the boat between the rocks and boulders until you reach the calm waters of the river. Lunch follows at a riverside lodge.

SUBIC FREE PORT BASE TOUR

MT. PINATUBO VOLCANO TREKKING



Six Hundred years of silence, the awakening was sudden and devastating. In 1991, the once highest peak in Central Luzon (1,745 meters) without tell-tale signs of warning erupted in a maelstrom of fury; spewing ashes in excess of 100,000 ft. into the stratosphere. The biggest eruption of the 20th century left a catastrophic legacy so tragic this generation will never forget. Such is Mt. Pinatubo. This tour offers a panoramic view of lahar and pyroclastic material deposits that buried thousands of hectares of agricultural lands and townships; spectacular lahar canyons formed in its wake completing the poignant view of the once biggest rice producing province of Luzon.

Inclusions: Roundtrip transfers, use of 4x4 jeep, packed lunch, local guided trekking to the crater.
